

Herring Run Trail Race, July 17, 2021

Operational Plan

Phase 2 of NB Path to Green

Risk Assessment

- ~Risk Assessment will be changed if needed on the date of the event as provincial Covid cases and regulations change.
- ~It will be ongoing throughout the event as well.

Physical Distancing

- ~Capacity will be kept below 150, the allowable limit for Outdoor Formal events.
- ~Racer capacity is 115, Volunteer capacity will be kept under 25 giving us a total of 140 "if" everyone shows up. This will keep us under the 150 limit for Outdoor formal.
- ~The Kids race has been cancelled this year. Kids (unless registered for the 10k Full Herring Run) and spectators will be asked to stay home to keep numbers of people low
- ~Being an outdoor event, we will enforce a 2m distance between those of different friend circles and bubbles. Masks will be needed if otherwise.
- ~2m distancing reminder signs will be at the check in table.
- ~Marking flags will be spaced 2m apart for lines to the outhouse and the food line.
- ~20k Aid station will have racer drop bags spaced 2m apart.

Hand and Respiratory Hygiene.

- ~Volunteers and Race Directors (RD's) will be required to sanitize hands frequently during the day.
- ~Volunteers and RD's will be required to wear masks at check-in, while serving food and at any time people need to be closer than 2m.
- ~RD's and Volunteers will be required to sanitize hands before serving food.
- ~All racers and volunteers will be required to sanitize hands as they arrive at the event.
- ~Racers will be required to wear their masks at check-in, when receiving food and the start of the race. Once into the woods, after 200m, racers can take their masks off and keep in a pocket.
- ~Anyone using the outhouse will need to wear a mask, sanitize their hands before and after doing business.
- ~People in the food line up will be required to maintain at least a 2m distance. Once the racers arrive at the table to receive food, they must wear a mask and continue to maintain 2m distance.

Screening and Monitoring.

- ~A screening poster will be at the volunteer and Racer check in areas.
- ~A volunteer will ask racers and volunteers to read this poster, how many vaccines they've had and if anyone has a positive Covid test result.
- ~Contact tracing info has already been recorded for racers at registration time.
- ~Contact tracing info for Volunteers will be recorded as they arrive on site.

Receiving payment.

- ~iPad terminal will be sanitized between customers when purchasing swag.

Food serving station and eating.

- ~Racers will be encouraged to space at least 2m apart while eating.
- ~Food will be served by volunteers this year.
- ~Servers and those being served will be required to wear masks.
- ~Hand sanitizing will be done before people get water or juice.
- ~We have reusable cutlery and plates. Everyone will wash their own plate and cutlery in hot soapy water, rinse and place in drying rack.
